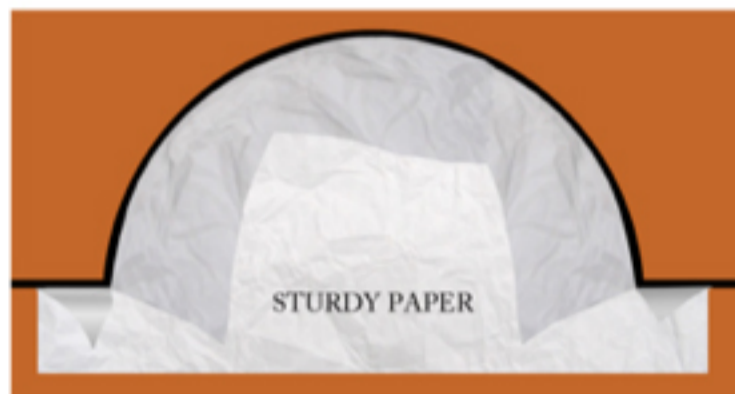


Made by the Forge's Making A Curved Bay Window Template

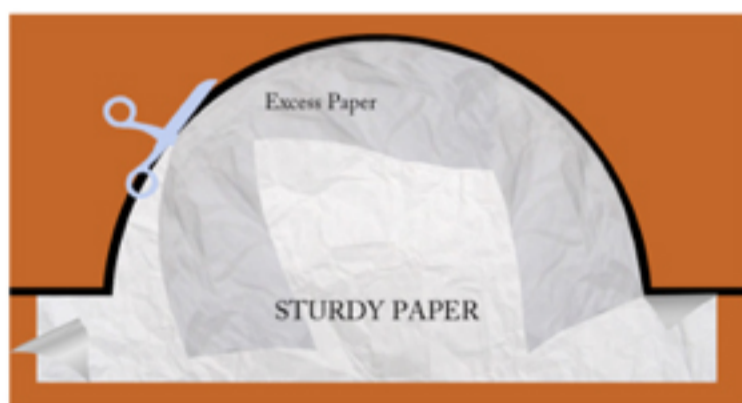
Making the perfect bespoke curved bay window pole is dependent on accurate to-the-millimetre measurements. At Made by the Forge, we encourage a 'belt and braces' attitude so we will require a full size template of your curved bay window.

1. Please use sturdy paper and if necessary, taped together pieces of sturdy paper.
2. Press the paper well into the shape of the bay on the floor. The excess paper will fold over. **IMPORTANT:** This shape must be the same on the floor as it is where you wish to mount the pole. If it is not we will need a template that accurately mirrors the shape of where the pole will fit.

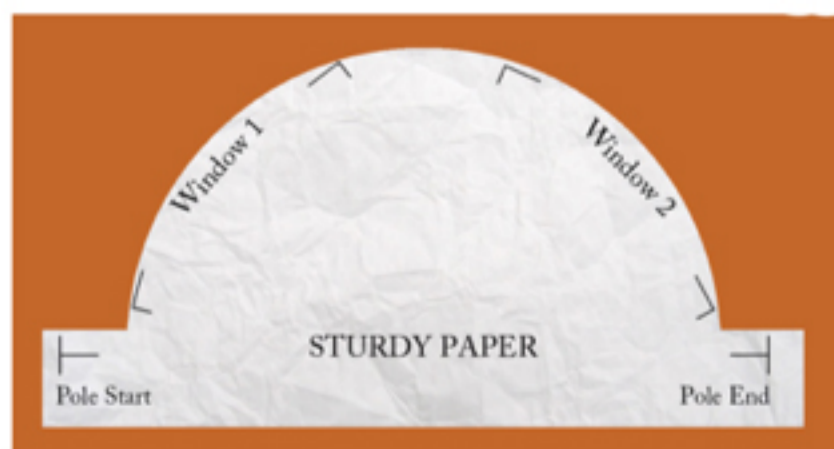


3. Using a felt tip pen, carefully draw the shape of the bay on the paper so that the edges of the paper represent the wall of the bay.
4. Carefully cut away the folded over pieces of paper so the inside edge mirrors the shape of the wall where the pole will fit. Please mark the template with where you wish the pole to start (including the finials) and finish (inc. finials) - plus include any obscuring items such as radiators or beams. Please also mark up where the windows are and also where you wish the brackets to be placed.

Remember - the inside shape of this template needs to be the same as the wall where the pole will go in order for it to fit.
